#### Land in Ownership

1. Land known as Ansells Copse situated on Caws Avenue – value – NIL
2. Land at the bottom of Solent View Road known as Seagrove Dell including the pond situated thereon – value – NIL.
3. Land situated between the junction of Greenham Drive, Matthews Way and Sirius Close – value – NIL
4. Building known as Puckpool Park Public Conveniences – value – NIL

5. The Parish Council holds a 99-year lease on Eddington Road Play Area (13.11.2008) from Vectis Housing Association – value – NIL
6. The Parish Council holds a 15-year licence on Pier Road Dinghy Park (04.10.2004) from Isle of Wight Council – value – NIL
7. The Parish Council holds a 50-year lease on Sandlands Allotments, Steyne Road, Seaview (01.09.10) from Isle of Wight Council - value - NIL
8. The Parish Council also owns the footpaths on Nettlestone Hill and Pondwell Hill – value – NIL
9. The Parish Council holds a 125-year lease on Public Conveniences at Seagrove Bay (15.04.19)
