**PIER ROAD DINGHY PARK**

You are invited to renew your DINGHY PARK permit(s), which will be valid from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021.

The Parish Council has agreed that all fees for 2021/2022 will be as follows:

ANNUAL **£110**

**(Catamarans and boats over 18ft will be charged at double the rate and require 2 permits)**

(Space is available for kayaks at £50 per annum)

SEASON **£80** (1st April – 30<sup>th</sup> Sept. or 1st Oct - 31<sup>st</sup> March)

Bookings will be taken on a first come, first served basis and must be accompanied by a cheque together with a **STAMPED, ADDRESSED ENVELOPE**. Please make **cheques payable to “NETTLESTONE AND SEAVIEW PARISH COUNCIL”** with your **Surname** written on the **reverse**.

Please provide name, address, e-mail address, contact telephone number and the name/description of your boat(s) – this can be by email to the Clerks address at the top of the page.

The lock combination will be changed at 12 Noon on Friday 9th April 2021.

Trailers or trolleys without a permit will be removed if left in the dinghy park.

Purchase of a permit acknowledges acceptance of the conditions.

**Please ensure that the permit is affixed to your boat and clearly visible. If a cover is fitted tightly the permit must remain available for inspection (on the cover?).**

**Boats without a current permit clearly displayed will be removed.**

**PIER ROAD DINGHY PARK – FENCE REPLACEMENT WORK**

This is a notice to inform you that essential upgrade work will be taking place in the dinghy park in May 2021 as the Parish Council have been able to extend their tenancy by a further 15 years. The park will still be open at this time but users are urged to be mindful of construction equipment and other potential hazards during this period.

The fencing will be completely replaced – the wooden posts will also be replaced by reinforced concrete posts. This work will be carried out one section at a time so the park will remain secure during the work. Users should be aware that if they currently secure their boat to a fence post or section of fence, their boat will be detached from the fence/post during this work. The engineers may need to move some vessels to keep them away from construction areas but we will endeavour to keep disruption to a minimum.
